



Board of Port Commissioners Policy

No. 359: It is the policy of the Port District that all businesses are provided equal opportunity to participate in the performance of District contracting and leasing opportunities. The District is committed to take all necessary and reasonable steps to increase its utilization of small businesses.

- Good Faith Effort Reviews
- Payment of Prevailing Wages As Applicable

- Department of General Services SBE
- City of San Diego SLBE
- Small Business Administration
- Others as Identified and Approved

SBE Goal Methodology and Requirements

Subcontracting and SBE Availability

- SBE goals are based on availability of subcontracting and availability of small businesses.
- Incentives are provided on best value solicitations.
- SBE's are encouraged to respond as primes.

Requirements

Public Works

- Must meet SBE goal or demonstrate a good faith effort as part of being responsive
- Must be registered as a public works contractor w/California Dept. of Industrial Relations and pay prevailing wages

Best value: Evaluation Matrix and Bonus Points

- SBE participation 5 pts
- DVBE/Disabled Staff participation 5 pts
- Veteran Status 5 pts
- ADA Enhancements 5 pts (if applicable)



Procurement Services

Types of Solicitations

- Request for Bids (RFB)
- Request for Proposals (RFP)
- Request for Qualifications (RFQ)
 RFQs can be for on-call services
 and have agreements lasting 3-5 years.
- Public Works Bids (Construction)
- Request for Information (RFI)

Tips for eBidding

- Make sure you are registered and your information is up-to-date
- Project Managers may ask for companies in our Planetbids portal for small projects
- Read the Project details, key information, and note dates
- Make sure you can log in
- Download Documents
- Acknowledge Addenda (if any)
- Submit Responses



PORT PROCUREMENT THRESHOLDS



Services

- Greater than \$500k Competition & Board Approval
- Greater than \$125k & up to \$500k Competition Required
- Less than or equal to \$125k Direct Negotiate



Public Works (updated 1/1/2025)

- Greater than \$220k Competition, Board Approval
- Greater than \$75k up to \$220k Competition Required
- Less than or equal to \$75k Direct Negotiate



Purchase of Goods

- Greater than \$500k Competition, Board Approval
- Greater than \$40k Competition Required
- Less than or equal to \$40k No competition, Direct Purchase

Register as a vendor

- ✓ Access website: portofsandiego.org

- Registration as a vendor occurs on a secure web page hosted by PlanetBids







