## ORDINANCE 2707

## ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2012/2013 BUDGET TO AUTHORIZE TWO UNCLASSIFIED POSITIONS: DEPUTY PORT ATTORNEY I, II OR III AND LEGAL SECRETARY

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the Legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix I, (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) authorize two unclassified positions for the Port Attorney's Office, a Deputy Port Attorney I, II or III, and a Legal Secretary as the addition of these positions are necessary to enable the Port Attorney's Office to provide more legal services in-house in order to mitigate risk by being proactive and legally strategic especially with regard to project management issues and to reduce future costs of outside legal services; and

**WHEREAS,** the total cost for FY 12/13 increase for the remainder of the year applicable to the two positions is approximately \$80,000 with funds required for future fiscal years to be budgeted in the appropriate fiscal year.

**NOW THEREFORE,** the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Fiscal Year 2012/2013 budget is hereby amended to add two unclassified positions as follows: Deputy Port Attorney I, II, or III and Legal Secretary.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect on the 31<sup>st</sup> day from its passage by the Board of Port Commissioners.
