ORDINANCE 2819

ORDINANCE GRANTING LEASE AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO LEASE WITH INTREPID LANDING, LLC TO UPDATE CERTAIN LEASE PROVISIONS

- **WHEREAS**, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the Legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix I (Port Act); and
- **WHEREAS**, Section 87(b) of the Port Act grants authority to the District to lease the tidelands or submerged lands, or parts thereof, for limited periods, not exceeding 66 years, for purposes consistent with the trusts upon which those lands are held, by the State of California; and
- WHEREAS, Intrepid Landing, LLC (Intrepid) has a lease with the District at 2702 Shelter Island Drive to operate a commercial property on 32,604 square feet of land located along America's Cup Harbor (Commercial Lease); and
- WHEREAS, District consented to an encumbrance of Intrepid's leasehold estate by \$1,135,000 in favor of Torrey Pines Bank with conditions, and, in accordance with the Commercial Lease this consent can be conditioned on amending the Lease to bring it to the current standard which includes sustainable leasing language; and
- **WHEREAS**, Amendment No. 1 would update the Lease language to the District's current standard.
- **NOW, THEREFORE,** the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District does ordain as follows:
- Section 1. Amendment No. 1 to Commercial Lease with Intrepid Landing LLC, located at 2702 Shelter Island Drive, updating language to current District standards is hereby granted.
- Section 2. The Assistant Executive Director or his designated representative is hereby directed to execute said Amendment No. 1 to the Commercial Lease.
- Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 31st day from its passage by the Board of Port Commissioners.
