RESOLUTION ADOPTING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND AWARDING CONTRACT NO. 2012-20 TO DIAMOND LANE CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR TENTH AVENUE MARINE TERMINAL STRUCTURAL AND MOORING REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT (BERTH 10-1 AND 10-2 FENDER SYSTEM, SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA IN THE AMOUNT OF \$345,000

- WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and
- WHEREAS, Section 37 of the Port Act requires that the California Public Contract Code (CPCC) apply to public projects of the District; and
- WHEREAS, the District adopted the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (Accounting Act) procedures of the CPCC to apply to public projects of the District; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) adopted BPC Policy 110 incorporating the provisions of the Accounting Act to govern the processing and administration of public projects; and
- WHEREAS, District inspections and investigations, and site meetings with Marine Operations and Maritime Trade representatives, revealed damage to several of the cluster fender systems at TAMT Berths 10-1 and 10-2; and
- **WHEREAS**, maintenance at these locations is required to protect the seawall and provide safe berthing facilities; and
- WHEREAS, maintenance will consist of repair and replacement of the existing deteriorated or damaged fender and chain (festoon) assemblies, buckling fenders, steel brackets and tubes at ten pile clusters along TAMT Berths 10-1 and 10-2; and
- **WHEREAS**, the construction bid documents for the project were advertised on January 8, 2013; and
- **WHEREAS**, on February 8, 2013, six (6) bids were received ranging from \$345,000 to \$610,000; and

WHEREAS, the low bid, submitted by Diamond Lane Contractors in the amount of \$345,000 is considered responsive and responsible, and award to this bidder is recommended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, hereby adopts and awards Plans and Specifications for Contract No. 2012-20 to Diamond Lane Contractors, Inc. for the Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal Structural and Mooring repair and replacement (Berth 10-1 and 10-2 Fender System) San Diego, California, and the Executive Director or his designated representative is hereby authorized to enter into Contract No. 2012-20 with Diamond Lane Contractors, Inc. for the Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal Structural and Mooring repair and replacement (Berth 10-1 and 10-2 Fender System) San Diego, California in the amount of \$345,000.
