RESOLUTION 2014-120

RESOLUTION WAIVING BPC POLICY NO. 110, PART 1.G.3, TO INCREASE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S CHANGE ORDER EXECUTION AUTHORITY FROM 6% TO 14% OF THE ORIGINAL CONTRACT AMOUNT FOR CONTRACT NO. 2012-10

- WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the Legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix I (Port Act); and
- WHEREAS, Section 37 of the Port Act requires that the California Public Contract Code (CPCC) apply to public projects of the District; and
- WHEREAS, the District adopted the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (Accounting Act) procedures of the CPCC to apply to public projects of the District; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) adopted BPC Policy No. 110 incorporating the provisions of the Accounting Act to govern the processing and administration of public projects; and
- WHEREAS, Part 1.G.3 of BPC Policy No. 110 authorizes the Executive Director, or authorized designee, to negotiate and execute change orders for this contract up to an aggregate of 6% of the original contract amount; and
- WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1 is almost 8% of the original contract amount; and
- WHEREAS, staff recommends that the BPC increase the Executive Director's change order execution capacity for Contract No. 2012-10 from 6% to 14% of the original contract amount; and
- **WHEREAS**, this will restore the Executive Director's original change order capacity for other potential change order costs.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District hereby waives BPC Policy No. 110, Part 1.G.3, to increase the Executive Director's change order execution authority from 6% to 14% of the original contract amount for Contract No. 2012-10 increasing the Executive Director change authority capacity from \$61,788 to \$145, 545.
