RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH ENVIRON INTERNATIONAL CORPORATION FOR \$88,000 TO COMPLETE THE CLIMATE ACTION PLAN INVENTORY UPDATE AND CONTINUED SUPPORT FOR INITIAL IMPLEMENTATION

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the Legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix I (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2013, the Board of Port Commissioners (Board) adopted a Climate Action Plan (CAP); and

WHEREAS, the CAP identifies baseline greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions for all existing uses of and operations on District tidelands; and

WHEREAS, in order to guide implementation of the CAP, the Board adopted BPC Policy No. 750 "Guidelines for Implementing GHG Reduction Measures," which, among other things, provides for the creation a comprehensive GHG emission inventory, to be updated every three years, in order to gauge GHG emissions reduction; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends entering into an agreement with Environ International Corporation for \$88,000 to complete the GHG inventory for 2006 and 2013, which is intended to accomplish the three year update pursuant to BPC Policy No. 750, and to provide other assistance on CAP implementation to the District from December 10, 2014, through December 31, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, as follows:

That the Executive Director or his authorized designee is authorized to execute an agreement with ENVIRON International Corporation for \$88,000 to complete the Climate Action Plan inventory update and provide continued support for CAP implementation in substantial conformance to the proposed agreement included as Attachment A to the corresponding Agenda Sheet on file with the District Clerk.
