

RESOLUTION 2014-62

**RESOLUTION SELECTING AND AUTHORIZING A
PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH FIREBLAST 451,
INC. DBA FIREBLAST GLOBAL FOR AN AMOUNT
NOT TO EXCEED \$374,858.32**

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) adopted BPC Policy No. 110 for the administration of contracts, agreements, the purchasing of supplies, materials, and equipment, and grants; and

WHEREAS, in 2004, the Harbor Police Department (HPD) acquired a modular live fire training simulator for the purpose of training its officers in marine firefighting operations; and

WHEREAS, in early 2013, HPD determined the need to replace the current fire training simulator with a new modular training system that meets the most current technology and officer safety mandates while insuring the highest level of training; and

WHEREAS, in June 2013, HPD was awarded \$300,000 in reprogramed grant funding through the Department of Homeland Security, Port Security Grant Program Fiscal Year 2011 grant to supplement funding a new training simulator; and

WHEREAS, on January 22, 2014, the District issued Request for Bids 13-42 "Fire/Tactical Training Simulator Including Removal of Current Simulator, Installation of New Simulator and Training;" and

WHEREAS, the District notified 570 vendors of the opportunity; and

WHEREAS, Fireblast 451, Inc. dba Fireblast Global submitted the lowest responsive bid at \$374,858.32.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, as follows:

That the low bid of Fireblast 451, Inc. dba Fireblast Global for a Fire and Tactical Training Simulator in an amount not to exceed \$374,858.32 is hereby accepted and the Executive Director or his designated representative is hereby

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authorized and directed to execute the purchase agreement on behalf of the San Diego Unified Port District with Fireblast 451, Inc. dba Fireblast Global.
