

RESOLUTION 2014-63

RESOLUTION SELECTING AND AUTHORIZING A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH FIREBLAST 451, INC. DBA FIREBLAST GLOBAL FOR REMOVAL OF THE OLD SIMULATOR, INSTALLATION OF THE NEW SIMULATOR AND TRAINING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$6,500

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) adopted BPC Policy No. 110 for the administration of contracts, agreements, the purchasing of supplies, materials, and equipment, and grants; and

WHEREAS, on January 22, 2014, the District issued Request for Bids 13-42 "Fire/Tactical Training Simulator Including Removal of Current Simulator, Installation of New Simulator and Training"; and

WHEREAS, Fireblast 451, Inc. dba Fireblast Global submitted the lowest responsive bid at \$381,358.32, which included \$374,858.32 for purchase of the simulator and \$6,500.00 for removal of the current simulator, installation of the new simulator and training.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, as follows:

That the low bid of Fireblast 451, Inc. dba Fireblast Global for removal of the old simulator, installation of the new simulator and training in an amount not to exceed \$6,500 is hereby accepted and the Executive Director or his designated representative is hereby authorized and directed to execute the purchase agreement on behalf of the San Diego Unified Port District with Fireblast 451, Inc. dba Fireblast Global.


