**RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING SUPPORT OF

2014**

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, Section 21 of the Port Act authorizes the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) to pass all necessary ordinances and resolutions for the regulation of the District; and

WHEREAS, National Public Works Week (NPWW) is a celebration of the tens of thousands women and men in North America who provide and maintain the infrastructure and services collectively known as public works; and




