## **RESOLUTION 2015-113**

RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AS WELL AS AWARDING CONTRACT No 2015-16 TO GLOBAL POWER GROUP, INC. FOR THE LED STREET LIGHTING RETROFIT PROJECT FY 15/16 IN THE AMOUNT OF AND NOT TO EXCEED \$304,145.94 AS AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2015/2016 MAJOR MAINTENANCE BUDGET

- WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and
- WHEREAS, Section 37 of the Port Act requires that the California Public Contract Code (CPCC) apply to public projects of the District; and
- **WHEREAS**, the District adopted the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (Accounting Act) procedures of the CPCC to apply to public projects of the District; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) adopted BPC Policy 110 incorporating the provisions of the Accounting Act to govern the processing and administration of public projects; and
- **WHEREAS**, in January 2013, the District was awarded \$1.38 million in reimbursable funds through SDG&E's Partnership Program to promote and create energy efficiency, energy-conservation, on District tidelands from January 2013 through December 2014; and
- **WHEREAS,** In January 2015, the District was awarded an additional \$690,000to develop and implement energy efficiency projects during the 2015 calendar year; and
- WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 (FY15/16) Major Maintenance Program provides for the retrofitting of street and park lights with light emitting diode (LED)s, which will significantly decrease the District's energy consumption at several tideland locations; and
- **WHEREAS**, the engineer's original estimate for the work was \$190,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the retrofitting contract details were advertised on June 30, 2015 with the District receiving nine (9) bids ranging from \$304,145.84 to \$713,37964; and

**WHEREAS**, the lowest and responive bid received was by Global Power Group for \$304,145.94.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, hereby approves the plans and specifications and authorizes the Executive Director or her designated representative on behalf of the San Diego Unified Port District to enter into Contract No. 2015-16 with Global Power Group for the retrofitting of the street and park lights all along the District Tidelands as described in the Major Maintenance Program, not to exceed the amount of \$304,145.96 as authorized by the board
