## **RESOLUTION 2015-169**

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REVISIONS TO THE PROJECT SCOPE FOR HARBOR POLICE HQ INVESTIGATIONS BUILDING REPLACEMENT AND RE-ADVERTISEMENT OF DISTRICT CONTRACT NO. 2015-24

- WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and
- **WHEREAS**, Section 37 of the Port Act requires that the California Public Contract Code (CPCC) apply to public projects of the District; and
- WHEREAS, the District adopted the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (Accounting Act) procedures of the CPCC to apply to public projects of the District by Resolution 98-249; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) adopted BPC Policy No. 110 incorporating the provisions of the Accounting Act to govern the processing and administration of public projects; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Harbor Police Department currently utilizes two elevated modular trailers as office and work station space for Investigation Officers and Supervising Sergeants; and
- WHEREAS, a project was scoped to replace the existing trailers with a new district owned modular office building with construction of concrete foundations and utility connections; and
- **WHEREAS**, construction bid documents were advertised electronically on October 8, 2015; and
- **WHEREAS**, two (2) bids were received on October 28, 2015 and the BPC rejected all bids because the bids exceeded the project budget; and
- **WHEREAS**, staff recommends re-advertising the project with a modified scope that aligns with the project budget of \$500,000; and
- **WHEREAS**, the modified scope will identify items that are non-essential and the District will re-advertise with a new project scope; and
  - WHEREAS, staff recommends that the BPC authorize the reduction of the

scope of the improvements, and re-advertise the contract for new bids.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, as follows:

Staff is authorized to reduce the project scope for the Harbor Police HQ Investigations Building Replacement and re-advertise Contract No. 2015-24.
