RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO EACH OF THE AS-NEEDED AGREEMENTS **ENGINEERING** FOR MARINE STRUCTURAL SERVICES WITH BERGERABAM. INC.. CORP., TRITON TRANSYSTEMS AND INC., **INCREASING** THE ENGINEERS. **AGGREGATE TOTAL BY \$800,000 FROM \$900,000** TO \$1,700,000 WITH NO INCREASE REQUIRED TO THE APPROVED CAPITAL **IMPROVEMENT** PROGRAM MAJOR **MAINTENANCE** AND PROJECT BUDGETS

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2013, the Board of Port Commissioners authorized agreements with BergerABAM, Inc., TranSystems Corp., and Triton Engineers, Inc. for as-needed services for marine structural engineering to support implementation of the District's Major Maintenance and Capital Improvement Programs (CIP); and

WHEREAS, the aggregate capacity of the three agreements is a not-to-exceed amount of \$900,000 over a period of three years, and the District has expended or obligated approximately \$850,000 as of March 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends an increase of \$800,000 to the aggregate agreement capacity to support implementation of the District's Major Maintenance and Capital Improvement Programs through FY 2016; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the Board authorize Amendment No. 2 to each of the as-needed agreements for marine structural engineering services with BergerABAM, Inc., TranSystems Corp., and Triton Engineers, Inc., increasing the aggregate total by \$800,000 from \$900,000 to \$1,700,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, as follows:

That the Assistant Executive Director or his designated representative is hereby authorized and directed to execute Amendment No. 2 to each of the asneeded agreements for marine structural engineering services with BergerABAM,

Inc., TranSystems Corp., and Triton Engineers, Inc., increasing the aggregate total by \$800,000 from \$900,000 to \$1,700,000.
