WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and


WHEREAS, for many years, the District retained federal lobbying services in Washington, D.C., as is a common practice for public agencies; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, the District terminated these services due to budget constraints; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends initiating a request for proposals to select a federal lobbying team.




