

RESOLUTION 2015-81

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN MOU BETWEEN THE DOWNTOWN SAN DIEGO PARTNERSHIP AND THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED PORT DISTRICT TO PROVIDE MUTUAL INDEMNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE WORK YOUR WAY HOME PROGRAM FOR HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS ON TIDELANDS

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, addressing the homeless population along Tidelands continues to be a priority for the District; and

WHEREAS, the Downtown San Diego Partnership (Partnership) currently operates the Work Your Way Home Program where a homeless individual is reunited with a support system from their home town; and

WHEREAS, the program offers an individual an opportunity to return home and is not a shuffling of the individual from one jurisdiction to another; and

WHEREAS, to further address the homeless population on Tidelands, the District is proposing to enter into an MOU with the Partnership to help fund the Work Your Way Home Program on tidelands; and

WHEREAS, under the proposed MOU, for individuals on tidelands, the District will pay the Partnership for the cost of a ticket for the individual with the total District expenditure under the MOU not to exceed \$45,000 over three years, and in lieu of paying any administrative fees to the Partnership, the District is providing long-term storage space for property, and the MOU provides District will indemnify Partnership.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, as follows:

That the Executive Director or her designated representative is hereby authorized on behalf of the San Diego Unified Port District to enter into the MOU

with the Downtown San Diego Partnership to participate in the Work Your Way Home Program for homeless individuals on tidelands including indemnification by the District.


