RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FY 2014-2018 5-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM TO INCREASE THE TAMT PHASE II DEMOLITION - TRANSIT SHED #1, BAY A, B, C DESIGN PROJECT COST BY \$1 MILLION TO CONDUCT APPROXIMATE 70 PERCENT DESIGN FOR THE DEMOLITION OF TRANSIT SHED #1 AND OTHER IMPROVEMENTS
