

RESOLUTION 2016-144

**CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARING ON THE USE OF
AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READER
TECHNOLOGY FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT
INVESTIGATIONS AND CALIFORNIA AIR
RESOURCES BOARD COMPLIANCE WITH THE
DISTRICT'S GREEN TRUCK PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1 (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, California Civil Code (CC) Section 1798.90.55 requires that a public agency that operates or intends to operate an Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR) system shall provide an opportunity for public comment at a regularly scheduled public meeting of the governing body of the public agency before implementing the program; and

WHEREAS, the District owns and operates eight mobile mount ALPRs as part of the Automated Regional Justice Information System (ARJIS); and


WHEREAS, the District also operates three fixed mount ALPRs, one of which is located at the entrance to the Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal and two are mounted at the entrance of the National City Marine Terminal (District Terminals) to monitor California Air Resources Board (CARB) compliance of the large trucks entering District Terminals for the District's Green Truck Program; and

WHEREAS, both the ARJIS and CARB programs were in place and the systems were in use prior to the implementation of CC Section 1798.90.55; and

WHEREAS, staff requests that the Board of Port Commissioners hold a Public Hearing to receive public input for the District's ALPR systems for ARJIS and CARB as required by CC Section 1798.90.55.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District shall conduct a Public Hearing at a regularly scheduled public Board Meeting to consider public input regarding the eleven total ALPRs for ARJIS law enforcement investigations, and for California Air Resources Board compliance with the District's Green Truck Program.
