RESOLUTION APPROVING TRANSFER OF FUNDS WITHIN THE FY 2014 - 2018 CIP BUDGET APPROPRIATION FROM PROGRAM CONTINGENCY TO THE SITE PREPARATION AT CHULA VISTA BAYFRONT PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$200,000.00 PURSUANT TO BPC POLICY NO. 90 AND NO. 120

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, the District's 2014 - 2018 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) includes Project No. P0460 (Project), recently renamed Site Preparation at Chula Vista Bayfront and expanded to add the preparation of the existing site and to accept excess fill material leading to substantial savings to the District; and

**WHEREAS**, to effectuate the added scope, staff recommends adding \$200,000 to the Project from CIP Program Contingency, in accordance with BPC Policies No. 090 and 120; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, as follows:

The 2014 - 2018 Capital Improvement Program is hereby amended by transferring \$200,000 to Project No. P0460, Site Preparation at Chula Vista Bayfront, from CIP Program Contingency.
