ADOPTING RESOLUTION **PLANS** SPECIFICATIONS AND AWARDING CONTRACT NO. 2015-32 (BASE BID SCHEDULE, ADDITIVE **BID SCHEDULE A & ADDITIVE BID SCHEDULE B)** TO **ENSLEY ELECTRIC.** INC. **FOR** DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FY GRANT-FUNDED PROJECTS, IN THE **AMOUNT OF \$923.270** A) SAN DIEGO BAY REGIONAL FIBER OPTIC INFRASTRUCTURE (PHASE 9) INSTALLATION, SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA (BASE BID SCHEDULE, ADDITIVE BID SCHEDULE A); AND B) SAN DIEGO NORTH BAY WIDE AREA VIEW CAMERAS INSTALLATION. SAN DIEGO. CALIFORNIA (ADDITIVE BID SCHEDULE B)

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1 (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, Section 37 of the Port Act requires that the California Public Contract Code (CPCC) apply to public projects of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District adopted the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (Accounting Act) procedures of the CPCC to apply to public projects of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) adopted BPC Policy No. 110 to establish a policy governing the processing and administration of public projects, consulting and service agreements, the purchasing of supplies, materials, and equipment, and grants; and

WHEREAS, in October 2014, the BPC authorized acceptance of the Federal Emergency Management Administration/Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Port Security Grant Program (PSGP) for fiscal year 2014 (FY14); and

WHEREAS, included in the \$2,014,563 award, were projects for the Phase 9 continuation of the San Diego Bay Regional Fiber Optic Infrastructure (Fiber), and another project for the implementation of the San Diego North Bay Wide Area View Cameras (WAVCam); and

WHEREAS, both projects increase domain awareness around San Diego Bay; and

WHEREAS, the Phase 9 Fiber improvements are geographically focused on the Point Loma and Shelter Island areas of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to BPC Policy 110, the construction bid documents for the "San Diego Bay Regional Fiber Optic Infrastructure (Phase 9)" were advertised on January 7, 2016; and

WHEREAS, on February 4, 2016, the Bid Opening revealed nine (9) bids, seven (7) of which were deemed responsive; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bid, for a total amount of \$923,270, was submitted by Ensley Electric, Inc. (Ensley) and is considered both responsive and responsible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, hereby approves the plans and specifications and awards Contract No. 2015-32 (Base Bid Schedule, Additive Bid Schedule A and Additive Bid Schedule B) to Ensley Electric. Inc. for two Department of Homeland Security FY 2014 grant-funded projects, in the amount of \$923,270: A) San Diego Bay Regional Fiber Optic Infrastructure (Phase 9) Installation, San Diego, California (Base Bid Schedule, Additive Bid Schedule A), and B) San Diego North Bay Wide Area View Cameras Installation, San Diego, California (Additive Bid Schedule B).

The Executive Director or her designated representative is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the San Diego Unified Port District to enter into Contract No. 2015-32 (Base Bid Schedule, Additive Bid Schedule A and Additive Bid Schedule B) to Ensley Electric, Inc. for two Department of Homeland Security FY 2014 grant-funded projects, in the amount of \$923,270.
