

RESOLUTION 2017-143

RESOLUTION REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR CONTRACT NO. 2016-05 TENTH AVENUE MARINE TERMINAL ENTRY GATE SECURITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT DUE TO ALL BIDS EXCEEDING THE PROJECT BUDGET, AND AUTHORIZING REVISIONS TO REDUCE SCOPE AND RE-ADVERTISE THE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the Legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix I, (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, Section 37 of the Port Act requires that the California Public Contract Code (PCC) apply to public projects of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District adopted the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (Construction Act) procedures of the PCC to apply to public projects of the District by Resolution 98-249; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) adopted BPC Policy No. 110 incorporating the provisions of the Construction Act to govern the processing and administration of public projects; and

WHEREAS, Contract No. 2016-05 Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal (TAMT) Entry Gate Security Improvements is a construction contract to provide and install a new unclimbable fence, vehicle bi-fold speed gates, and pedestrian security turnstile gate, at TAMT, other work will include demolition of existing fence, gates, pedestrian gate, bollards, arms, curb and gutter, placing concrete curb and gutters, footings, bollards, installing conduits and electrical system and other site preparations; and

WHEREAS, contract documents were advertised on July 20, 2017 with an Engineer's Estimate and project budget of \$340,000; and

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2017, three (3) bids were received ranging from \$497,000.00 to \$557,950.00; and

WHEREAS, the apparent low bid was \$497,000; and

WHEREAS, the apparent low bid, submitted by Conan Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$497,000 is considered non-responsive as they do not carry the required A license; the second lowest bid, submitted by AZ Construction Inc. dba ACE Fence Co. in the amount of \$544,168, is considered responsive and responsible; and

WHEREAS, the second lowest bid is over the project budget of \$340,000; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends adopting a resolution to reject all bids and authorizing revisions to reduce scope, and re-advertise the contract for new bids.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) of the San Diego Unified Port District, as follows:

The District shall reject all bids for Contract No. 2016-05 Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal (TAMT) Entry Gate Security Improvements.


FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, revisions to the scope and re-advertisement of Contract No. 2016-05 TAMT Entry Gate Security Improvements are hereby authorized.



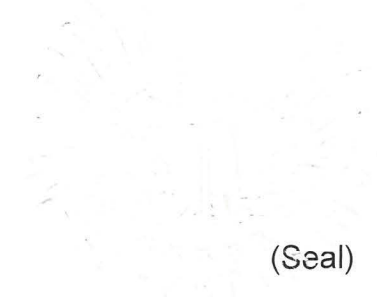
