RESOLUTION APPROVING TRANSFER OF FUNDS WITHIN THE FY 17/18 CAPITAL MAJOR MAINTENANCE BUDGET APPROPRIATION FROM CAPITAL MAJOR MAINTENANCE CONTINGENCY TO THE NATIONAL CITY MARINE TERMINAL BERTH 24-10 STRUCTURAL AND MOORING REPAIRS PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$225,000 PURSUANT TO BPC POLICY NO. 90

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, the District is currently constructing the National City Marine Terminal (NCMT) Berth 24-10 Structural and Mooring Repairs project; and

WHEREAS, during the final months of construction, unanticipated subsurface conditions required minor design modifications to the project; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends an increase of \$225,000 to the FY17/18 project budget from \$340,000 to \$565,000 to allow for successful completion of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District approves transfer of funds within the FY 17/18 Capital Major Maintenance budget appropriation from Capital Major Maintenance Contingency to the National City Marine Terminal (NCMT) Berth 24-10 Structural and Mooring Repairs Project in the amount of \$225,000 pursuant to BPC No. 90.
