## **RESOLUTION 2018-104**

RESOLUTION WAIVING BPC POLICY NO. 110. SECTION II.B. AND **AUTHORIZING** AGREEMENT WITH ALPHA PROJECT FOR THE HOMELESS TO PROVIDE OUTREACH AND INTERVENTION SERVICES FOR THE HOMELESS TIDELANDS, POPULATION ALONG AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,400,000.00 FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS BEGINNING JULY 1. 2018. FY 2019 EXPENDITURES ARE BUDGETED. ALL FUNDS REQUIRED FOR FUTURE FISCAL WILL BE BUDGETED YEARS IN APPROPRIATE FISCAL YEAR, SUBJECT TO BOARD APPROVAL UPON ADOPTION OF EACH **FISCAL YEAR'S BUDGET** 

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and

**WHEREAS**, at the December 2013 Board of Port Commissioners (Board) meeting, staff was directed to enter into an agreement with Alpha Project, a non-profit organization, to provide outreach and intervention services to the homeless population along Tidelands, mainly in the San Diego area; and

**WHEREAS**, since this original contract, staff has been directed by the Board to enter into a series of one-year agreements to continue the Alpha Project services provided to the homeless; and

**WHEREAS**, staff proposed a new agreement that would continue these services for a period of up to five years, and provides for these services to be provided 7 days per week during the duration of the agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends the Board select and authorize a sole source agreement with Alpha Project for the Homeless to provide outreach and intervention services to the homeless population along Tidelands, in an amount not to exceed \$1,400,000 for a period of up to five years from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2023.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, as follows:

That the Executive Director or her designated representative is hereby authorized on behalf of the San Diego Unified Port District to execute a sole source agreement with Alpha Project for the Homeless to provide outreach and

intervention services to the homeless population along Tidelands, in an amount not to exceed \$1,400,000 for a period of up to five years from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2023.
