

**RESOLUTION 2019-088**

**RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND AWARDED CONTRACT NO. 2018-27 TO 3-D ENTERPRISES, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,297,000 FOR THE SWEETWATER BICYCLE PATH AND PROMENADE PROJECT, CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA, AS AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD IN THE FY 2019-2023 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM, REIMBURSABLE THROUGH THE CALIFORNIA NATURAL RESOURCES AGENCY'S URBAN GREENING PROGRAM, GRANT AGREEMENT NUMBER U29130-0**

**WHEREAS**, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the Legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix I; and

**WHEREAS**, Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) Policy No. 110 establishes a policy governing the processing and administration of public projects, consulting and service agreements, the processing of supplies, materials, and equipment, and grants; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sweetwater Bicycle Path & Promenade project (Sweetwater Path) is the first of multiple segments of bikeway and promenade improvements located within the Chula Vista Bayfront and ultimately the bikeway and promenade will create a spur loop connecting to the Bayshore Bikeway at the northern and southern ends of Chula Vista Bayfront; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sweetwater Path segment connects existing Bayside Park (site of future Harbor Park), which marks the project's southern limit, to Bay Blvd. at E Street, which delineates the project's northern limit, most of Sweetwater Path is located within the future Sweetwater Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the primary features of Sweetwater Path include three-quarters of a mile of Class I bike path and pedestrian promenade, a pre-engineered pedestrian bridge, irrigation, the planting of 100 trees/large shrubs, 3.8 acres of shrub and groundcover planting, and installation of signage, benches and trash receptors; and

**WHEREAS**, the project is a recipient of the Urban Greening Grant in the amount of \$4,800,000; and

**WHEREAS**, upon award of the grant staff engaged KTUA, the landscape architect for the Harbor and Sweetwater Parks at Chula Vista Bayfront, to design the Sweetwater Path assuring the design is consistent with the Chula Vista Bayfront master planning and policy objectives and coordinated with the future Harbor and Sweetwater Parks; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 14, 2019, the Contract Documents including plans No. CV-2018-02 and specifications No. 2018-27 were issued for advertisement; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 12, 2019, five (5) bids were received ranging from \$4,297,000 to \$5,344,316.39; and

**WHEREAS**, the lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by 3-D Enterprises, Inc. at \$4,297,000; and

**WHEREAS**, District staff recommends that the BPC approve the plans and specifications and award Contract No. 2018-27 consisting of the base bid and all additive bid schedules to 3-D Enterprises, Inc. in the amount of \$4,297,000 for the construction of the Sweetwater Bicycle Path and Promenade project.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, hereby approves the plans and specifications and authorizes and directs the Executive Director or her designee to enter into Contract No. 2018-27 with 3-D Enterprises, Inc. in the amount of \$4,297,000 for the Sweetwater Bicycle Path and Promenade project, Chula Vista, California, as authorized by the Board in the FY 2019-2023 Capital Improvement Program, reimbursable through the California Natural Resources agency's Urban Greening program, grant agreement number U29130-0.
