- (d) At all times offer and be prepared to perform terminal operator services for the general public without discrimination or preference;
- (e) Hold the District and its agents, officers and employees free and harmless and indemnified against any liability pertaining to or arising out of the performance of terminal operator services upon the facilities of the District by the Terminal Operator;
- insurance with an insurance carrier satisfactory to the District with the District to be named as additional assured. Such public liability and property damage insurance shall be maintained in full force and effect at all times that the Terminal Operator is a party to a Terminal Operator Agreement with the District.

 Such insurance shall be in amounts of not less than \$250,000 for one person injured in one accident, and not less than \$500,000 for more than one person injured in one accident, and in the amount of not less than \$250,000 with respect to any property damage.
