Project Title: Replacement of Water Fountain Tiles at Cancer Survivors Park  
Project Location – Specific: 3600 N. Harbor Drive, San Diego, CA 92101

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The proposed project involves the replacement of the water fountain tiles at Cancer Survivors Park in San Diego, California. The proposed project would repair deterioration of existing ceramic tiles on an existing water fountain, consequently extending their useful life. The existing tiles would be replaced with glazed cobalt blue tiles. Specific work to complete the proposed project includes the following:

- Removal and replacement of the existing blue tiles; and
- Waterproofing of the newly installed tiles.

It is anticipated that construction would commence in late 2017 and would take approximately two months to complete. Due to its nature and limited scope, construction of the proposed project would generate a minor amount of vehicle trips and would require limited use of construction equipment. Finally, the applicant would be responsible for complying with all applicable federal, state, and local laws regarding construction demolition debris recycling, hazards and hazardous materials, and stormwater.

Reason Why Project is Exempt: The project is determined to be Categorically Exempt pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and 15302 (Replacement or Reconstruction) and Sections 3.a. and/or 3.b of the District's Guidelines for Compliance with CEQA because the project is the replacement of tiles on an existing water fountain that would involve no expansion of use beyond that previously existing, would be located on the same site, and have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure being replaced. Furthermore, the project would not result in any significant cumulative impacts due to the continuation of the existing use. Section 3.a (4) of the District's CEQA Guidelines is as follows:
