Project Title: *Intelligent Lighting Pilot Program*

Project Location – Specific: District jurisdiction in the city of San Diego

**Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:** *The Intelligent Lighting Pilot Program is a three-month trial program to install 23 sensor nodes on existing streetlight fixtures located along N. Harbor Drive generally between Laurel Street and G Street. The purpose of the program is to create a network of sensors that provide real time data on traffic movements and parking behavior to inform public safety and to better understand mobile and pedestrian activity in the area. Each node would be equipped with a camera and two microphones, as well as sensors for environmental inputs such as temperature, pressure and vibration. The sensors would be attached to existing streetlights and would be relatively inconspicuous given that they are approximately 23" L x 13" W x 14.3" H in size and would be designed to blend in with the existing streetlight fixtures. At the end of the three-month trial period, the District would assess the program and determine if Intelligent Lighting technologies should be terminated, continued, and/or expanded to include a larger geographical area and/or more data collecting capabilities. Further discretionary approvals from the District may be required should the proposed project be continued and/or expanded.*

**Reason why project is exempt:** *The three-month Intelligent Lighting Pilot Program to install 23 sensor nodes along N. Harbor Drive is categorically exempt pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Sections 15301 (Class 1 – Existing Facilities), because it results in a minor alteration to existing public facilities and it involves the addition of safety or health protection devices in conjunction with existing facilities, Section 15304 (Class 4 – Minor Alterations to Land) because the sensor involve a minor temporary use of land having negligible or no permanent effects on the environment and would not involve the removal of mature, scenic trees, and Section 15306 (Class 6 – Information Collection) because the sensors will gather real time data on traffic movements and parking behavior to better understand mobile and pedestrian activity in the area. Furthermore, the Intelligent Lighting Pilot Program is also categorically exempt from the District's Guidelines for Compliance with CEQA, Sections 3.a Existing Facilities, and 3.f Information Collection for the same reasons noted above. Sections 3.a and 3.f of the District's CEQA Guidelines are as follows:*

3.a. *Existing Facilities (SG § 15301) (Class 1): Includes operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public and private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing, including but not limited to:*

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- (7) Existing facilities used to provide electric power, natural gas, sewerage, or other public utility service.
- (10) Addition of safety or health protection devices for use during construction of or in conjunction with existing structure, facilities, or mechanical equipment, or topographical features including navigational devices.

AND/OR

3.d. Minor Alterations to Land (SG § 15304) (Class 4): Includes minor alterations in the condition of land, water and/or vegetation not involving removal of mature, scenic trees, including, but not limited to:

- (6) Minor temporary use of land having negligible or no permanent effects on the environment.

AND/OR

3.f. Information Collection (SG § 15306) (Class 6): Includes basic data collection, research, experimental management, and resource evaluation activities which do not result in a serious or major disturbance to an environmental resource. These may be for information gathering purposes, or as part of a study leading to an action which has not yet been approved, adopted or funded.

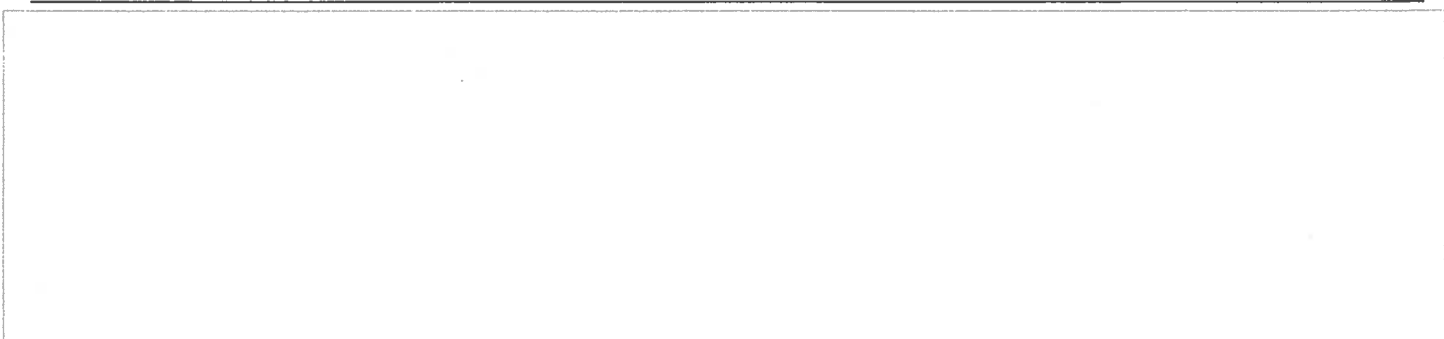
