Project Title: *Groundwater Monitoring Well Demolition by Tesoro Refining and Marketing Company at Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal*

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: *The proposed project would involve demolition of an existing groundwater monitoring well by Stantec Consulting (Applicant) on behalf of the Tesoro Refining and Marketing Company (Tenant) in the City of San Diego, California. Work to complete the proposed project would involve destruction of one (1) groundwater monitoring well, pressure grouting the well, and restoring to match surrounding surface with patched asphalt. Construction of the proposed project is anticipated to occur in the beginning of winter 2020 and would take approximately one day.*

Due to its nature and limited scope, construction of the proposed project would generate a minor amount of vehicle trips and would require limited use of equipment. Therefore, impacts related to air quality, greenhouse gas emissions, and transportation and traffic are not anticipated to occur. Furthermore, the Applicant would be responsible for complying with all applicable federal, state, and local laws regarding construction demolition debris, hazards and hazardous materials, and stormwater.

The proposed project would also include issuance of a Right of Entry License Agreement (ROELA). The areas proposed for use under this ROELA would be used by the Applicant and their authorized agent(s) and contractor(s) for the purpose of well demolition, as well as ingress and egress in support of those activities. It is anticipated that the ROELA would have a total term of approximately three (3) years or upon completion of work. The ROELA may be terminated by the District as a matter of right and without cause at any time upon providing twenty-four (24) hours written notice to Applicant of such termination.

Reason Why Project is Exempt: *The proposed project is determined to be Categorically Exempt pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Sections 15301 (Existing Facilities) and 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land), and Sections 3.a. and 3.d. of the District's Guidelines for Compliance with CEQA because it consists of demolition of a groundwater monitoring well and would involve no expansion of use beyond that previously existing, would not result in a significant cumulative impact due to the continuation of the existing use,*

would result in no permanent effects on the environment, and would not involve the removal of mature, scenic trees. Sections 3.a. and 3.d. of the District's CEQA Guidelines are as follows:
