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**Project Title:** *Upgrades to Existing Pedestal on Shelter Island Drive by Cox Communications*

**Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:** *The proposed project would involve upgrading an existing pedestal by Cox Communications (Applicant) in the city of San Diego, California. Work to specifically complete the proposed project would involve the installation of a new 30"x48" vault in an existing dirt median adjacent to the curb on Shelter Island Drive and trenching 20' to connect the new vault to the existing pedestal. The larger vault is needed to accommodate equipment upgrades which cannot successfully occur in the existing pedestal. Both the existing pedestal and proposed vault are located within an existing dirt median covered with rock, and no increase in impervious area would result as part of the proposed project. All existing trees within the dirt median are to remain in place, and the contractor shall restore the project site back to its original condition following completion of work.*

*Construction of the proposed project is anticipated to occur in approximately Spring of 2023, and would take approximately 3-5 days to complete, with ongoing modifications and maintenance as needed. The proposed work requires a five (5) person crew and work truck to complete the project, and the work truck would be temporarily parked curbside to allow the crew to manually install the new vault. The Applicant is responsible for implementing a Traffic Control Plan (TCP), and nearby driveway access would be maintained at all times during construction. The proposed project would not result in road closures on Shelter Island Drive.*

**Reason Why Project is Exempt:** *The proposed project is determined to be Categorically Exempt pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Sections 15301 (Existing Facilities) and 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) and Sections 3.a. (7) and 3.c. (3) of the District's Guidelines for Compliance with CEQA because it consists of upgrades to an existing pedestal that would involve no expansion of use beyond that previously existing and would consist of the installation of small new equipment in small structures. Section 3.a. (7) and 3.c. (3) of the District's CEQA Guidelines is as follows:*

- 3.a. Existing Facilities (SG § 15301) (Class 1): Includes operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing.  
 (7) Existing facilities used to provide electric power, natural gas, sewerage, or other public utility service.
