


## April 2025 Workshop Summary

On April 30, 2025, the San Diego Unified Port District (Port of San Diego) invited Barrio Logan residents and other interested parties to help shape the next phase of improvements at César Chávez Park. The workshop was held at Barrio Station from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. The presentation was delivered in English and Spanish interpretation was available. Landscape architecture firm Civitas facilitated the workshop.

The presentation included background information and analysis of the project site. The scope centers on potential next-phase enhancements to the southeast corner of the park—an area of approximately 0.4 acres—while also considering the southern half as a whole to ensure the proposed improvements align with the broader context. A series of engagement activities were prepared to encourage participation, and attendees were invited to ask questions and provide feedback directly on the printed boards. Photos of the printed boards are included on the following pages.

To collect additional input, the design team launched a public survey on April 30, which remained open through early June. The survey included all of the

in-person workshop graphics and invited feedback on topics such as active and passive recreation, and improvements people would like to see. The survey questions and results from the survey are provided on the following pages.





## April – June 2025 Stakeholder Outreach

Between April and June 2025, the design team conducted a series of stakeholder meetings with local organizations to inform the design process and ensure that community needs are reflected in future improvements to César Chávez Park. These meetings helped gather local knowledge, understand community priorities, and build collaborative relationships with groups deeply connected to the neighborhood.

Stakeholder groups included:

- Barrio Logan Community Planning Group
- Barrio Station
- Barrio Logan Association
- Calvary Baptist Church
- Chicano Park Steering Committee
- Chicano Park Museum and Cultural Center
- Environmental Health Coalition
- Perkins Elementary
- San Diego Ship Repair Association
- Our Lady of Guadalupe Church

These conversations highlighted César Chávez Park as a valued but underused community asset with deep cultural and recreational significance. Stakeholders emphasized the need for safer crossings, improved access, and additional parking. There was strong interest in enhancements that support family activities, soccer, and expressions of cultural identity—such as nature play, murals, lighting, shade, and water access. Participants also voiced a strong desire to reconnect the community to the bay and to create a welcoming public space that honors the area's heritage.

Insights from these discussions helped inform the scope of the current planning effort and set priorities for future improvements.

## May 2025 Pop-Up Workshops

The design team conducted 3 pop-up workshops to gather additional feedback.

At these pop-up workshops, community members had the opportunity to ask questions [to the Port staff and Design Consultant team] and provide feedback. Paper copies of the online surveys were also made available at the pop-up workshops.




# SurveyMonkey Summary


Survey Language Distribution (Total: 164)








How often do you typically visit César Chávez Park?  
*¿Con qué frecuencia suele visitar el Parque César Chávez?*




## How Do People Use and Perceive the Existing Park?


Which of the following describes how you would typically use Cesar Chavez Park? (Select all that apply.)




Would anything make you feel more comfortable when visiting or more likely to visit Cesar Chavez Park? (Select all that apply.)



# Summary of Key Findings from Survey

The following Survey summary is organized by the following categories: Family Gathering and Celebration, Passive Recreation, Active and Creative Play, Waterfront Experience, Access and Parking, and Comfort and Maintenance. The feedback will be used to help create design alternatives. A raw export of the open-ended survey comments is provided as an attachment to this summary report (pages 13–52).

## Family Gathering and Celebration

- Respondents expressed strong interest in more spaces for social interaction, community events, and celebrations.
- From a design perspective, incorporating flexible gathering spaces with movable seating, shade structures, built-in BBQ facilities, and outdoor “rooms” can provide a variety of settings for both planned and spontaneous community gatherings. Together, these features encourage cultural expression, support informal social connection, and make the park feel like a true extension of the community’s living space for the community and visitors.

## Passive Recreation

- César Chávez Park is appreciated as a peaceful, natural retreat within the Barrio Logan neighborhood. Many survey respondents expressed interest in features that encourage quiet enjoyment.
- Design strategies can reinforce this by providing shaded paths, seating nooks, smaller gathering areas, and gardens. These elements create space for reflection, curiosity, and quiet enjoyment, broadening the park’s appeal to elders, caregivers, introverts, and anyone seeking a moment of ease.

## Active and Creative Play

- Respondents expressed interest in a variety of

features that expand opportunities of active and creative play, supporting enjoyment, well-being, and connection for all age groups.

- On the ground, this translates into a mix of ADA accessible play equipment, interactive art, water elements, and musical installations that invite exploration from people of all ages and abilities, turning the park into a multi-sensory destination for learning and joy.

## Waterfront Experience

- Cesar Chavez Park represents this community’s connection to the bay, with the existing pier providing then most direct connection to the water. The southwest corner of the park has potential to serve as a gateway to the pier.
- Design enhancements may transform the pier landing into a vibrant anchor for the park, activating and celebrating the bayfront experience.

## Access and Parking

- Survey participants highlighted the need for improved parking and access conditions alongside other mobility upgrades. Improvements can help ensure that the park is easy to reach and welcoming for all visitors, regardless of how they travel.
- Although not included in the current scope of work, options for increasing high-demand parking include time-limited public parking (to encourage more frequent turnover) or designated spaces for park users. This helps ensure that those who want to visit the park in a vehicle have access to a space in the parking lot.
- Future design improvements could include the introduction of drop-off and loading zones, along with stronger pedestrian, bike, and transit connections into Barrio Logan to reduce reliance on cars.

- A combination of policy coordination and thoughtful design can help support a more balanced and inclusive access strategy.

## Comfort and Maintenance

- Respondents reflect a desire for spaces that feel welcoming, secure, and cared for by the community. Design can also support a greater sense of ease—through features like well-lit paths, open sightlines, and active edges.
- Many visitors noted that park conditions—especially cleanliness, functionality, and a sense of safety—directly influence their comfort and willingness to spend time in the space.
- High-use areas like the restrooms, pier, and playground highlight the need for consistent upkeep to ensure these spaces remain welcoming, hygienic, and enjoyable for everyone.





### How do you typically travel to and from Cesar Chavez Park when you visit?






































