The Arts, Culture & Design Committee and Art Selection Panel members serve as advisory body to the Board of Port Commissioners and Parks & Recreation Department on matters related to arts and culture within the District's jurisdiction. The ACDC and Art Selection Panel members assist in upholding the District's vision of tidelands as a world-class arts and cultural destination and supports the development of arts and cultural programs within the District's jurisdiction.

Please note: Elected officials, agents, officers, and employees of the District and its member cities are not eligible for an appointment to the ACDC or Art Selection Panels. Additionally, ACDC members cannot accept any of the aforementioned positions while serving on the ACDC. Artists serving on the ACDC or Art Selection Panels are not eligible to compete for any art projects offered by the Port.
