

SPONSOR APPLICATION (20**26)**TO EXHIBIT ARTWORK/OBJECTS ON PORT TIDELANDS

Applications are due by 5PM on January 31, 2026

INTRODUCTION:

The Port of San Diego's Parks & Recreation Department conducts an annual review of external requests from sponsors who want to temporarily exhibit artwork or objects on Port property or donate artwork or objects to the Port of San Diego. This review process enables the Port to effectively evaluate proposals and plan workload around projects on an annual basis. Sponsors are strongly encouraged to submit applications well in advance of desired installation timeframes to ensure adequate time for conceptual development, evaluations, and internal review processes.

The purpose of this application is to gather preliminary information that will be used to evaluate the proposal's alignment with the Port's acceptance criteria, its feasibility, and its overall appropriateness for potential exhibit or placement on Port property. Recommendation for advancement is not a guarantee that an artwork or object will be exhibited on Port property or become a part of the Port's Public Art Collection. It is merely a recommendation to advance to the next phase of review.

NOTE: This application is for sponsors with projects that are fully funded and are interested in donating and/or exhibiting artwork or objects on Port Tidelands. Open calls for proposals, qualifications and commissions are located on the "Public Art Opportunities" page of the Port's website and distributed in the email newsletter.

Electronic Submission: Application and attachments may be combined in a single .zip file not to exceed 10 Mb and submitted electronically via email to the Director at arts@portofsandiego.org.

Paper Submission: Print and submit the application by mail to: Port of San Diego, Parks & Recreation Dept., PO Box 120488, San Diego, CA 92112-0488; or hand deliver to 3165 Pacific Highway, San Diego, CA 92101.

In order to be eligible for review, fully completed applications <u>must be received</u> by the **Parks & Recreation**Department no later than 5:00PM PT on <u>January 31, 2026</u> for the 2026 review cycle. No late submissions will be accepted. Note, inclusion in the 2025 review cycle does not mean that artworks proposed will be exhibited in 2025.

Sponsors will be notified by April 2025, or sooner, of the status of the proposal.
