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On May 31, 2022 at approximately 2211 hours, I was on patrol as 504C in full police uniform in a marked patrol vehicle. Officer Della Valle #6266 and I responded to the Hilton Hotel at 1 Park Blvd for a report of a domestic disturbance that occurred in room #1242.

## INVESTIGATION:

Upon my arrival, I activated my Body Worn Camera. Sergeant Morris #4565, Officer Hennigan #5213, and Officer Lynch #6181 were speaking with Hilton security officers who had relayed [REDACTED]'s, Hilton front desk agent, statement to us. [REDACTED]'s statement documented in Officer [REDACTED]'s Officer statement #12896.

The abbreviated statement was that [REDACTED] had interacted with [REDACTED] who said she had been attacked and required a bandage for a scratch on her chest. Security Officers said when they escorted [REDACTED] up to her room to retrieve her possessions that [REDACTED] slammed the door once [REDACTED] entered the room and would not open it for them.

Based on the statement of [REDACTED] and the security officers, we had reason to believe there had possibly been domestic violence between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Security Officers escorted us up to room #1242 where they were staying. I knocked on the door, announced myself as a police officer, and that we needed to speak with them. Nobody answered the door. I knocked and announced myself several more times until [REDACTED] opened the door but only while the security latch was up. She said it was enough to speak through the latch but I told her we needed to see [REDACTED] to make sure she was ok. We believed she may be in danger and we needed to verify her well being. [REDACTED] exited the room and [REDACTED] slammed the door closed when [REDACTED] exited the room.

I asked [REDACTED] if she would talk to me about what happened and she agreed if we moved farther away from the room. [REDACTED], Officer Lynch, and I went around to where the public elevators were and she gave me her statement. [Not Verbatim]

## STATEMENT OF [REDACTED]: (VICTIM)

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were in a domestic relationship for the past three years. They lived together and had multiple possessions in common including the dog that was in the hotel room with them. [REDACTED] said she left the room to get dinner for [REDACTED] and herself. Their food order was delayed so it was longer than normal before she returned with the food. Upon [REDACTED]'s return, [REDACTED] began harassing her about what took her so long. [REDACTED] accused [REDACTED] of cheating on them and that [REDACTED] was just out sucking dick, among other accusations. [REDACTED] began repeatedly hitting their head and [REDACTED] became concerned for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] could not remember if [REDACTED] was hitting their head against the wall or with their hands because [REDACTED] was also throwing objects around the room at the same time. [REDACTED] was not directing the objects she was throwing at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] did not put her hands on [REDACTED] at any point throughout the altercation. [REDACTED] looked in the mirror and saw the scratch on her chest. When asked if there was anything else the scratch could have come from besides [REDACTED] or her actions she said there was not. [REDACTED] left the room because she thought she had her car keys but after leaving she realized she did not and [REDACTED] had locked her out. [REDACTED] went down to the front desk for help getting back into

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the room. When security escorted [REDACTED] back up to the room to retrieve her belongings, [REDACTED] entered the room to try and talk to [REDACTED] to calm her down.

[REDACTED] has a history of mental illness but did not make any direct statements that led her to believe she wanted to hurt herself or anyone else.

[REDACTED] emphatically told me she did not want to press charges against [REDACTED] for the domestic violence.

[End of Statement]

During [REDACTED]'s statement she partially removed the bandage on the right side of her chest. I observed a scratch mark that had broken the skin and was approximately half an inch in length. [REDACTED] stated the scratch mark was from [REDACTED] during their physical altercation. I later took a photo of [REDACTED] and the scratch with my department issued ARJIS phone and uploaded the photos to Evidence.com.

Based on [REDACTED]'s statement, I believed [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were in a relationship, there was a physical altercation between them, [REDACTED] was the dominant aggressor, and [REDACTED] sustained a minor injury from the altercation. I believed [REDACTED] was in violation of 273.5 PC - Domestic Violence w/ Injury.

Officer Della Valle spoke to [REDACTED] through the door while I was speaking with [REDACTED]. He was able to get a brief statement from [REDACTED], which he documented in officer statement #12895.

After speaking with officers through the door, [REDACTED] opened the door. Officers Gonzalez and Officer Segneri #6134 placed [REDACTED] in handcuffs. I placed [REDACTED] under arrest for 273.5 PC - Domestic Violence with Injury and informed [REDACTED] she was under arrest. I attempted to admonish [REDACTED] and get a full statement but [REDACTED] would not let me complete the admonishment. I told [REDACTED] if she wanted to give me her statement she had to let me read her the admonishment before I could ask about the incident. [REDACTED] did not want to and I did not ask any questions regarding the incident. I searched [REDACTED] incident to arrest. I observed there was what appeared to be an open crack in the skin approximately an inch long on [REDACTED]'s upper forehead. This was consistent from what [REDACTED] was saying about [REDACTED] repeatedly hitting herself in the head. I later took photos of the injury with my ARJIS phone and uploaded them to Evidence.com.

I entered hotel room #1242, which the had been staying in. The room was disheveled. Both their possessions and items that appeared to be room decorations were strewn about the room and laying on the ground. Their was a pizza box containing slices of pizza that appeared to have been thrown inside the room. There was glass on the ground, which appeared to be from a glass panel covering a canvas that was on the wall. there was a dog sitting on the bed, which [REDACTED] said she and [REDACTED] owned in common. Officer Della Valle took photos of the state of the room and impounded them to Evidence.com.

Due to the damage in the hotel room, Hilton Hotel staff decided to evict [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] from the room. Hotel staff was not sure if they were willing to press charges yet for the vandalism to the hotel

Arriving on scene I activated my Body Worn Camera (BWC) and met Officer K. Meriwether #6155, Officer L. Downey #6141, Officer L. Lynch 6181, Officer P. Hennigan #5213, Corporal R. Colon #4535 and Sergeant K. Morris #4565 in the hotel lobby. We proceeded to room 1242.

Officer L. Downey knocked on room number 1242 and announced himself as San Diego Harbor Police. No one answered the door. Officer L. Downey knocked and announced several more times before the suspect, later identified as, [REDACTED] (DOE [REDACTED]), answered the door. [REDACTED] kept the security latch on the door preventing it from opening all the way. Officer L. Downey requested if there were any other persons in the room. I used my left arm to weave through [REDACTED]'s left arm and my right hand to control [REDACTED]'s left wrist. I applied pressure to the hand and wrist to manipulate them into the small of her back for handcuffing.

**NARRATIVE:**

Upon arrival, I positioned myself behind several officers who were talking with [REDACTED] through a crack in the door and attempting to have her exit the room. [REDACTED] was a suspect in a felony domestic violence call. Officers on scene were attempting to deescalate the situation by speaking to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] opened the door and the Officers in front of me entered the room to perform a safety sweep checking for other occupants and weapons. I observed Officer Gonzalez attempt to place [REDACTED] in handcuffs when [REDACTED] actively pulled away from him, tensed her arms and body and refused to comply with his commands. I calmly explained to [REDACTED] that she needed to "relax."

I used my left arm to weave through [REDACTED]'s left arm and my right hand to control [REDACTED]'s left wrist. I applied pressure to the hand and wrist to manipulate them into the small of her back while Officer Gonzalez handcuffed the suspect. I also applied slight pressure with my body to control [REDACTED] against the door to prevent [REDACTED] from fleeing, hurting herself or Officers.

[REDACTED] was not injured and did not complain of pain during or after the use of force.

## Source Of Complaint

Sometime after the call for service (05/29/22) this case was discussed with the District Attorney (D.A.) for filing consideration. During those conversations, and with the standard review of the related BWC footage, the D.A. questioned the manner in which the arrest was made. Specifically, they articulated the difficulty of prosecution using the exception which was articulated to the fourth amendment (in the report). While not all opinions at the D.A.'s office were unanimous on the subject, it is possible the exception to the fourth amendment which was articulated in the report may not have applied. If the allegation(s) proves true, then Subject Employee might have violated (SOP # 340.3.2, SOP # 340.5.7, & SOP # 322.3).

## SUMMARY

Based on the concerns expressed by the D.A., I reviewed the reports submitted for case 22-02084. According to the written reports, the victim in this case [REDACTED] had been sharing a hotel room with the suspect [REDACTED] at the Hilton Bayfront hotel. The written reports do not articulate who rented the room. Police responded after [REDACTED] asked the front desk for a bandage after being scratched by [REDACTED] during an altercation in the room. Hilton security reported the incident to Harbor Police and ultimately escorted our staff to the room. After some negotiating through the closed door, [REDACTED] pushed [REDACTED] out of the hotel room and re-secured the door to the room, refusing to come out. Officers took a statement from [REDACTED] where they articulated valid PC for [REDACTED] [REDACTED] for 273.5 PC. The written reports indicate that [REDACTED] eventually opened the hotel room door and officers entered to conduct a "safety sweep", simultaneously taking [REDACTED] into custody just inside the hotel room door.

To better understand the details of the interaction, I reviewed the BWC associated with this case. The hotel staff, along with Sergeant Morris and several other officers, take the service elevator up to the room. During the elevator ride, hotel staff explains that [REDACTED]'s mother (a Hilton Diamond Club member) made the room reservation for [REDACTED]. This implies that [REDACTED] has standing in the hotel room which was further reinforced by the fact that hotel staff stated they were not yet willing to evict the occupants of the room.

Cpl. Colon's BWC video begins with a conversation between Sergeant Morris and Corporal Colon related to evicting the occupants of the room. Corporal Colon states that the incident could involve an eviction and Sergeant Morris corrects him explaining that the hotel is not currently wanting to evict anyone as the room reservation was made by a "diamond member". Sergeant Morris further explains that the hotel may be interested in an eviction later, only if the room is found to be damaged. This conversation with Cpl. Colon confirms that Sergeant Morris correctly heard the earlier explanation by hotel staff.

The BWC later shows [REDACTED] eventually open the door to the hotel room while never breaking the threshold into the hallway.

## SUMMARY (continued)

With the door open, Officers remained in the hallway next to the open door until Sergeant Morris, who is standing in front of the door, motions into the room (using his hands) and states, "Let's go". It was only after this direction that officers entered the room while [REDACTED] is heard saying, "I still don't give permission [to enter]".

I reviewed the written reports again specifically looking for a noted exception to warrantless entry. Finding only several mentions of a "safety sweep" I reviewed case law related to that exception.

- "[A protective sweep] is decidedly not automatic but may be conducted only when justified by a reasonable, articulable suspicion that the house is harboring a person posing a danger to those on the arrest scene." *Maryland v Buie* (1990)
- A "protective sweep" cannot be made for weapons, contraband or injured victims (though the rescue/emergency aid doctrine may apply in the latter case). *Brigham City, Utah v. Stuart* (2006)

In reviewing *Maryland v. Buie* (1990), the case limits "protective sweeps" to cases where officers have **lawfully entered**, are **making and arrest**, and have an **articulable suspicion** of a potential assailant. While I recognize that police reports may not contain all details of an incident, I could not find information in the written reports (for this case) that would allow me to identify a valid exception to warrantless entry.

Sergeant Morris was identified as the only subject officer as the evidence demonstrated the other officers on scene simply followed his seemingly flawed direction.

I noticed Sergeant Morris of this investigation on 07/28/2022 and interviewed him on 08/02/2022. Sergeant Morris opted to not have any representative present during the interview. Sergeant Morris recalled the incident and reviewed the related reports and BWC footage prior to the interview. Sergeant Morris affirmed the events as I described above and stated that once the victim exited the room, he did not have articulable facts to substantiate there was someone else in the hotel room besides the suspect.

Sergeant Morris affirmed that once the suspect ([REDACTED]) opened the hotel room door, she was still inside the threshold of the door and was articulating that she did not give permission to enter the room. Sergeant Morris further recalled that he motioned officers to enter the room. During his interview, Sergeant Morris stated, "The mistake I made...was she opened the door, but she did not step into the hallway, so she was still within her room...". Sergeant Morris offered explanation that the back-and-forth conversation between Harbor Police and hotel security about the conditions under which the hotel would evict the couple added to the confusing nature of the incident. The hotel ultimately did discover damage to the room and revoked the couple's lodging privileges. Sergeant Morris stated that while on scene he did not pick up on the problematic nature of the entry, after he reviewed the BWC footage for his interview, Sergeant Morris agreed that the entry into the room was a mistake.

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The San Diego Harbor Police Department completed an internal review to review if Sergeant Morris violated Department Policies 340.3.2(a), 340.5.7(b), & 322.3 related to an entry, search, and subsequent arrest of an individual in a hotel room (Case: 22-02084). The investigation found that you directed your subordinates to enter a hotel room where no valid exception to the warrant requirement existed.

The following are the specific findings of this investigation:
