

## August 2025 Workshop Summary

On August 26, 2025, the San Diego Unified Port District (Port of San Diego) held a public community workshop to solicit public input on three preliminary concept plans for César Chávez Park. The workshop was held at Perkins Elementary from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m., with the presentation delivered in English and Spanish interpretation available. The landscape architecture firm Civitas facilitated the session. This was the second community workshop for this project; the first was held in April 2025 to gain feedback on what kind of improvements people would like to see in the southeast corner of the park.

The presentation included a recap of previous community engagement efforts (stakeholder meetings, the previous community meeting, on-site pop-ups, and a survey in Spring 2025,) and provided an in-depth review of the results of the survey. Community

members were then introduced to the guiding design principles, followed by the presentation of three design concepts/alternatives developed by the project team.

After the presentation, community members were encouraged to provide their feedback through a series of interactive boards, where they selected their preferred features from each alternative, and through one-on-one discussions with the design team.

To gather additional input, a second public survey, which was available online and in hard copy, was launched on August 26 and remained open through November 5. The survey featured all the graphics from the in-person workshop and invited feedback on program elements and preferred design concepts. 

## May 2025 - January 2026 Pop-Up Workshops and Working Sessions

Following the August 2025 community meeting, the design team and Port staff conducted two additional pop-up events to gather additional feedback from community members who could not attend the in-person community event. In addition, Port staff presented the design alternatives to the Barrio Logan Planning Group on September 17, and held three working sessions with the Chicano Park Steering Committee.

At the pop-up workshops, community members had the opportunity to review graphics of the proposed design alternatives, engage with the design team and Port staff, ask questions and provide their feedback. Community members were provided with and encouraged to complete hard-copies of the online surveys.

## October 6, 2025 - Working Session with Chicano Park Steering Committee (CPSC)

Following the community meeting, and at the request of the Chicano Park Steering Committee, the design team conducted an in-person working session with members of the Chicano Park Steering Committee to review the concepts, discuss the history of the park, and to better understand the committee's thoughts and desires for the park enhancements. The following summarizes the key issues that were discussed.

### Water Access

1. The sandy beach area has cultural significance to the community. Even if it is not physically accessible, it is critical to maintain the beach as it is part of the community's connection between the land and the water.
2. The committee prefers a design solution that limits access to the water without requiring a physical barrier like a fence. Direct physical access to the water is not feasible due to safety and operational constraints, but the design should still support visual and cultural connection to the shoreline.
3. The committee believes the tugboats should be removed, as they feel the park should extend all the way into the water.
4. Prefer green and terraced shoreline over the rock revetment that exists on the west side of the pier.

### Parking

1. Parking is a major issue because enforcement of the existing lot is needed to help ensure availability. The CPSC suggests a partnership with surrounding tenants to allow public use of adjacent industrial parking.

### General Design

1. Prefer the kiosko, the geometry and what it means to the community.
2. ADA access was appreciated.
3. The idea of a water feature and allowing kids to play and touch that water was appreciated. One area of desire is to have the water be more centrally located than on one side of the park.

### General Comments (Outside of this scope of work for this current project)

1. Restrooms and no doors on the women's stall continue to be a concern and frustration.
2. Long term pollution and trash removal in the bay should be the goal.

## December 19, 2025 - Design Working Session Follow-Up with Chicano Park Steering Committee

Following the initial working session, the design team met again with the Chicano Park Steering Committee on December 19, 2025 to further refine the preferred direction. The discussion focused on advancing a hybrid concept and strengthening cultural and interpretive elements. The following summarizes the key issues that were discussed.

### Hybrid Concept – Kiosko + Beach

1. The committee supports exploring a hybrid between the Kiosko and Beach alternatives.
2. The beach could be relocated to one or two of the lower kiosko terraces, while other terraces remain natural ecological areas.
3. The beach terraces should be located as close to the water as feasible, without permitting direct access into the bay.
4. ADA access to the beach and all other areas remains important.

### Lighting

1. Lighting will be important, as the area is currently dark.

### Interpretation

1. Interpretation should be a major component of the design, and the addition of an interpretive consultant in the next phase would be beneficial.
2. Opportunities discussed include:
  - A digital video component (in Spanish and English) to share oceanography and cultural stories.
  - QR codes and informational signage.
  - Recognition of Kumeyaay history.
  - Interpretation of the Cannery Industry.
  - Enhancing or adorning the dividing fence to make it more visible and educational.

### Entry Path + Cultural References

1. The meander along the entry path remains important, referencing the legend of Quetzalcoatl, the serpent.
2. The committee is open to exploring a balance between the linear qualities of the current plans and patterning that reflects the serpent.

### Existing Trees

1. Provide tables at the base of existing trees, including ADA-accessible spaces.
2. Consider limbing trees up to create a mix of shaded and sunny areas.

### Entry Arch

1. Support for an entry arch/gateway at the beginning of the path to the pier.
2. The arch could reflect a kiosko form and incorporate interpretation upon entering the walkway.
3. It should celebrate the movement to reconnect the park to the bay, acknowledge the original fight to secure park access through the Coastal Commission, and recognize key individuals.

### Shade Pavilion

1. The shade pavilion should take on a kiosko form that aligns and connects with Chicano Park.
2. A mist garden below the kiosko was discussed, potentially incorporating an “ollin” symbol in the paving (Aztec symbol of life).
3. The kiosko form could be open with a lattice structure referencing Tlaloc, the water god.

## January 17, 2026 - Preferred Design Working Session with Chicano Park Steering Committee

Following continued coordination with the Chicano Park Steering Committee, the design team conducted a third in-person working session on January 17, 2026 to review the preferred design direction and gather additional feedback. The discussion focused on refinement of key design elements, comfort amenities, interpretation, and ongoing partnership. The following summarizes the key issues discussed.

### Park Unification

1. The committee supports further unifying the park, including improvements extending west of the central walk.

### Amenities + Comfort

1. Explore adding a drinking fountain with bottle fill (preferably near existing restrooms).
2. Consider incorporating misters within the shade pavilion for additional cooling.

### Beach Design

1. The committee understands grading constraints and supports the beach design, including the need for a low kick rail.
2. Explore integrating half-hexagon geometry into the kick rail.
3. Clarify whether sand will be permitted or if an alternative material is needed due to health/safety concerns.
4. Consider a two-sided bench to face both the beach and interior lawn.

### Water Feature

1. Some concern remains about the central location and whether it may create circulation or supervision challenges.
2. Alternative locations, such as within the palm circle west of the main walk, were discussed.
3. A mist feature below the pavilion was suggested as a supplemental or alternative option.
4. Questions were raised regarding long-term maintenance, monitoring, and water cleanliness.

### Interpretation

1. General alignment and support for interpretive components.
2. Alternative locations, such as within the palm circle west of the main walk, were discussed.
3. The committee wishes to remain actively involved as an interpretive consultant is brought on board.
4. Recognition of individuals who helped create the park is critical.

### Trees

1. Tree additions should be carefully considered to avoid excessive shade or hidden sightlines.
2. The current plan may include too many new trees; placement should be strategic.

# SurveyMonkey Results





# Overall Comments on 3 Design Alternatives

## Alternative 1 - The Beach/La Playa




THE TERRACES

- General support for The Terraces concept.
- Strong support for The Cabana, which is seen as unique compared to existing amenities and provides the most shade.
- Mixed feedback on The Perched Beach: some questioned its value, while others emphasized that the sand beach holds cultural significance and should be preserved, even if water access is not allowed.
- Interest in adding an amphitheater and elevated seating for gatherings and events.
- Participants noted that palm trees provide little shade and suggested incorporating larger shade-providing trees instead.

# Overall Comments on 3 Design Alternatives


## Alternative 2 - The YARD | “El Patio”



- General support for The Scrim concept.
- Some participants felt that The Pergola looks too similar to existing shade structures already present in the park.
- Several suggested incorporating the red steps shown in the Perched Beach precedent photos (as shown on pages 9 and 10 of this report) into this scheme and adding an amphitheater or stage to highlight the iconic Coronado Bridge backdrop. They noted that maintenance would be minimal if the elevated steps were made of concrete or similar durable materials.

# Overall Comments on 3 Design Alternatives

## Alternative 3 - The KIOSKO | “El Quiosco”



- Strong preference for the kiosko form and its cultural significance.
- General support for the Living Shoreline concept.
- Some felt that The Mirror looks too similar to existing shade structures in the park.
- People appreciated the geometric forms and shapes incorporated into Alternative 3.

## Overall Comments on 3 Alternatives

### Other Comments on Alternatives

- People like the idea of a water feature where kids can play.
- More elaborate shoreline design would prevent people from jumping the fence to get into the bay.
- Some people think a fence is seen as disrespectful and contrary to their worldview. They seemed open to exploring subtler options, such as a low seat wall that reduces the sense of separation. They value both visual and physical access to the water, though they recognize the current pollution and safety concerns expressed by the US Coast Guard prevents their children from safely entering it.
- Some people concerned if vegetation along the shoreline isn't well maintained (for all three shoreline ideas), overgrowth could result in homeless individuals jumping over the fence and congregating in that area, which could result in safety concerns.
- Some people strongly recommended that the team consider the addition of an amphitheater for gatherings and events in this area and explained that many other parks (mentioned Shelter Island and National City as examples) have amphitheaters built in that can be used by the community.
- One person expressed wanting something in this area of the park that does not already exist. For example, there is already a children's playground, so a sandy area for the kids isn't the best use of space. The focus of the design should be on gatherings and hosting events instead.
- Some people want tugboats removed and believe the park should extend into the water.
- Parking is a major concern because people want better enforcement of the existing lot and partnerships to use adjacent industrial parking.



#### Which living shoreline strategy do you prefer?



### What primary gathering space is most appealing to you?



### Which waterplay experience are you most likely to use?
































